Hostel Accommodation & Cafeteria Services:

- You may avail sharing accommodation at Doctors Hostel, HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh subject to availability & on payment basis. Hostel charges will be deducted every month from your stipend as per the institutional policy which may vary from time to time.
- **Hostel Fees** worth ***Rs. 67200/- (for first year) (Non-Refundable)** will have to be paid in advance at the time of admission and subsequently after first-year, same will be paid by the student every year (Second and third year). The Hostel fees are subject to be revised as per institutional policy.
- Hostel Accommodation will be provided to final retained students only.
- It is mandatory for residents residing in hostel premises to avail In-house cafeteria/Mess facility on payment basis. Mess Charges worth ***Rs. 54000/- (for first year) (Non-Refundable)** will have to be paid in advance at the time of admission and subsequently after first-year, same will be paid by the student every year (Second and third year). The mess charges are subject to be revised as per institutional policy.

Service Bond at HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh – As per the copy attached (Annexure-2).

1. If the student resigns during the residency tenure of the course he / she will be liable to pay Rs. 10 Lakhs + applicable GST & fees paid by the student till date will be forfeited.
2. After completion of MD course, he / she has to serve for 1 year at HBCH & RC or TMC Centres including any of the outreach units, failing which he / she will be liable to pay Rs. 25 Lakhs + applicable GST.

Admission Procedure & Fees:

1. PMC Registration is Mandatory for Retained Students.
2. At the time of admission, students will have to pay Rs. 94,500/- and Administrative Charges Rs.2500/- to HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh as per existing rules.

OR

Please bring Demand Draft of Rs.94,500/- in favour of **Tata Memorial Centre payable at Mohali** & Administrative Charges Rs.2500/- **by card payment** at the time of admission.

3. **Final retained students will have to pay registration/enrollment fee of Rs.11,000/- online to HBNI University as part of the admission process.**
4. All students are requested to open their bank accounts in ICICI Bank (HBCH & RC branch)

5. Original documents to be brought along with the 02 sets of self attested photocopies as per the check list (Annexure-1). **Please scan your documents before submission to the institute as the originals will not be given till the completion of your bond.**
6. Please bring a **Velcro Folder** as per size of your document to preserve your Original Documents.

collectively as "Sureties" other part,

Hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves and our respective heirs executors and administrators to pay to **Homi Bhabha Cancer Hospital and Research Centre, New Chandigarh, Punjab** (hereinafter referred as the '**HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab**', its successors and assignees, on demand the sum of Rs. 25,00,000/- / Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs or Rupees Ten Lakhs) + applicable GST as the case may be and as hereinafter contained together with interest thereon from the date of demand till the date of payment, in the event of breach of the conditions by the said PG student as set out below.

(3) WHEREAS, the said PG student has agreed to execute this bond with two sureties aforesaid and with such conditions as herein under written.

Now the conditions to be observed and complied with by the said PG student and their sureties are as under:

a) The PG student has voluntarily accepted admission to the PG course from _____ (D.O.J). The PG student has clearly understood that he/she will be required to sign a bond for completion of the residency tenure for the period of 3 years and binds himself/herself that he will complete the course, failing which he/she would be bound to pay Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs) + applicable GST to the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** forthwith on demand by the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** together with the interest there on from the date of default, at the rate prescribed of Government loans and prevailing on the date of demand or if payment is made in the country other than India, the equivalent amount of the currency of that country converted at the official rate of exchange between that country and India. This condition shall however, not be applicable to the candidate who is resigning before the final round of selection conducted by DMER/ AIQ the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** on prescribed dates decided by these Authorities.

b) The PG student clearly understands that in the event the said PG student continues the course for the entire duration of 3 years and on his successful completion he/she is required to serve for a minimum period of one year the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab**, including any of the outreach units supported by TMC, located in the non urban areas (such as ACTREC / Sangrur / Vizag / Varanasi / Muzaffarpur / Guwahati and any other areas) and he will be paid consolidated stipend as may be prescribed at that point of time and in any case it will not be less than the consolidated stipend paid to him / her on the date of qualifying in the said degree. The PG student further binds himself alongwith the sureties that in the event he / she fails to serve as stated herein before at the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** / or the mentioned outreach station, units as aforesaid for the said minimum period of one year, he will be liable to pay the sum of Rs. 25, 00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs) + applicable GST as a breach of condition. Student will not be allowed to leave during Service Bond period for any reason. Students will be allowed to appear for NEET-SS & if selected, can join the Medical College / Hospital only for further studies and complete remaining bond period after completion of their higher studies. Students on Bond if selected, for State or Central Govt. service then they have to take prior permission in writing for joining the service after completion of bond period.

4.) The sureties viz (i) _____ (ii) _____ do hereby jointly and severally covenant with the Centre that if the said PG student make default in payment of the sum of Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only) + applicable GST as mentioned above or any part thereof, together with interest thereon from the date of demand at Government rates for the time being in force on Government loans, the sureties shall on demand and without murmur pay to the Centre the said sum of Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only) + applicable GST together with interest thereon from the date of default at the rate levied for Government loan and prevailing on the date of demand and that the liability of sureties hereunder shall not in any way be affected by any time waiver or indulgence of any nature of any kind whatsoever given made or shown by the Centre to or in favour of the said PG students. The sureties hereby agree that to all intents and purposes the liability of the sureties for the payment of all the sum of money under this agreement shall be deemed that of the principal parties each of both the sureties, jointly and severally.

5.) Notwithstanding anything herein contained, it shall be lawful for the Centre to terminate the tenure of the Residency of the course, if his / her progress has been found to be Unsatisfactory by the centre or any violations of the rules / regulations, as applicable or for the other reason of which the centre shall be sole judge, and in that event the said amount of Rs. 10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs Only) + applicable GST as contained in Para 4 above shall become payable by said P.G. Students / sureties immediately and the said PG student shall be bound to pay the same and if he / she fails to do so, the sureties shall be jointly and severally responsible to pay the same to the centre on demand.

6.) It is expressly understood by the said PG Students and the sureties herein that that the **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** shall be entitled to recover the said sum of Rs. 25,00,000/- / Rs. 10,00,000/- + applicable GST as the case may be in the event of default of their payment on demand and that **HBCH & RC, New Chandigarh, Punjab** shall be entitled to initiate civil / criminal proceedings as may be required at the cost, risk and consequences of the said PG student and the sureties thereon.

This agreement shall in all respects be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and the courts in SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try the dispute and adjudicate between the parties.
